League Fixtures Published

All of the 2013 fixtures have now been published on the site (you may need to refresh your browser to see these). Considerable efforts have been made to rotate venues and maintain an even spread of home and away games but inevitably some duplication of last year's arrangements may occur. Clubs should check their details are correct, particularly relating to the declaration of county players. Team manager contact details will be circulated shortly.



The League has received 38 entries across the four age groups, the same as last summer. Whilst the U15 group remains the same size, the U17 and U11 Leagues have reduced by one each and the U13s have received a record entry this summer with twelve teams.

It is appreciated that there will be some who feel that this is too many games (at U13) but these objections are not shared by players who have often voiced their feelings that the amount of cricket offered throughout a whole summer, often as little as four or five matches, is simply not enough to engage and retain their interest. The U13 age group is usually the largest and most popular section of clubs and deserves a decent programme of league cricket.

Although half of the SNCL clubs are not playing in the Junior Alliance, consideration has been accorded to those who are. There are only three weeks over the whole summer where these clubs will be obliged to play two U13 or U15 fixtures and the removal of the obligation for clubs to rearrange weather affected fixtures further reduces pressure on the season's fixture diaries.

The U17 League will remain as two groups with the winner's round to decide the title. This will finish earlier than the other groups as in the past some teams have experienced difficulties in fulfilling their fixtures later in the season.
